I would like to sincerely thank you for the one thousand 2x3 improved stoves built in Sinuapa, Ocotepeque. I was one of a number of Peace Corps volunteers who sent in a joint solicitud for stove projects last June and I want you to know how great I think your organization's work is. I have since returned to the US but will always have wonderful memories of Proyecto Mirador and its work in Honduras.

Most Peace Corps volunteers learn about the need and benefits of improved stoves either during training or their 2 years of service.
